

MINUTES
WALDRON SCHOOL BOARD SPECIAL MEETING
APRIL 27, 2011
5:30 P.M.

A special board meeting of the Waldron School Board was held in the Central Office Building, Wednesday, April 27, 2011, at 5:30 p.m. Board members present were Tammye Sherrill, James Nelson, and Stuart Byford. Board members Steve Bunting and David Harrison were absent. Others present were Superintendent Suzanne Bailey, Ashli Hutchens, Paulette Crouthers, Bob Wolfe, Ryan Walker, Amy Slater, and Traci Brown.

President Sherrill called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.

A motion was made by James Nelson and seconded by Stuart Byford to approve the AAIMS 2011-13 Contract. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by James Nelson and seconded Stuart Byford to amend the agenda to move Item III to Item II. Motion carried 3-0.

Ryan Walker presented information and answered questions from the board concerning the sale of the Boys & Girls Club property located behind Central Office. Members of the board tabled the item until the May board meeting.

The special board meeting was suspended at 6:00 p.m. to hear expulsion hearing information.

President Sherrill called the expulsion hearing to order at 6:00 p.m.

President Sherrill stated that the purpose of this meeting was to hear information concerning the recommendation for expulsion of a student.

The student was represented by himself. President Sherrill asked the student if he wanted the meeting open or closed, in which he stated he wished the meeting to be open to the public.

A motion was made by Stuart Byford and seconded by James Nelson to expel the student for one calendar year. Motion carried 3-0.

Members of the board adjourned from the expulsion hearing at 6:03 p.m.

Members of the board adjourned to executive session at 6:04 p.m.

Board member Steve Bunting entered the meeting.

Members of the board returned from executive session at 7:17 p.m.

A motion was made by Stuart Byford and seconded by James Nelson to accept the resignation of Chris Arnold at the end of the 2010-11 school year. Motion carried 3-1.

A motion was made by James Nelson and seconded by Stuart Byford to accept the voluntary resignation of Jody Slagle based upon job abandonment. Motion carried 4-0.

A motion was made by Steve Bunting and seconded by James Nelson to hire Jerry Strasner on a 245 day contract as the District Professional Development and Curriculum Support/Operational Plant Administrator with an administrative stipend of \$6,000.00 existing on the current administrative stipend schedule. Motion carried 4-0.

A motion was made by James Nelson and seconded by Stuart Byford to adjourn from the special board meeting. Motion carried 4-0.
