

MINUTES
WALDRON SCHOOL BOARD SPECIAL MEETING
OCTOBER 5, 2011
6:00 P.M.

A special board meeting of the Waldron School Board was held in the Central Office Building, Wednesday, October 5, 2011, at 6:00 p.m. Board members present were Tammye Sherrill, James Nelson, and Stuart Byford. Board member Steve Bunting was absent. Others present were Superintendent Suzanne Bailey, Paulette Crouthers, and Amanda Garrett.

President Sherrill called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

President Sherrill stated that the purpose of this meeting was to hear information concerning the recommendation for long-term suspension of a student.

Carol Wagner, mother of the student recommended for long-term suspension, represented the student at this meeting. President Sherrill asked Ms. Wagner if she wanted the meeting open or closed, in which she stated she wished the meeting to be open to the public.

A motion was made by James Nelson and seconded by Stuart Byford to suspend the student long-term so long as she receives mental health counseling services with costs, if any, to be at the expense of the parent, and evaluations provided to the district regarding the health and well-being of the student and if student is able to return to the school environment as well as documentation from the court system. The student will be suspended for a total of 19 days. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by James Nelson and seconded by Stuart Byford to adjourn from the hearing. Motion carried 3-0.
