

MINUTES
WALDRON SCHOOL BOARD SPECIAL MEETING
NOVEMBER 3, 2014
5:30 P.M.

A special board meeting of the Waldron School Board was held in the Central Office Building, Monday, November 3, 2014, at 5:30 p.m. Board members present were Steve Ewing, Tammye Sherrill, Eddie Harrison, and Brian Jones. Board member Steve Tull was absent. Others present were Superintendent Gary Wayman, Ashli Hutchens, Kim Solomon, Tammy Madden, Josh Brown, Chris Lipham, and Gary Clepper.

President Ewing called the meeting to order at 5:37 p.m.

President Ewing stated that the purpose of this meeting was to hear information concerning the recommendation for expulsion of three students, which will be referred to as Student A, Student B, and Student C, for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year.

Student A was represented by the student's father and he asked that the meeting be open.

Superintendent Wayman recommended that Student A be expelled for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year.

A motion was made by Tammye Sherrill and seconded by Eddie Harrison to accept the recommendation of the superintendent to expel Student A for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year. Motion carried 4-0.

Student B was represented by the student's grandmother and she asked that the meeting be open.

Superintendent Wayman recommended that Student B be expelled for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year.

A motion was made by Eddie Harrison and seconded by Tammye Sherrill to accept the recommendation of the superintendent to expel Student B for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year. Motion carried 4-0.

Student C was represented by the student's grandmother and she asked that the meeting be open.

Superintendent Wayman recommended that Student C be expelled for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year.

A motion was made by Tammye Sherrill and seconded by Eddie Harrison to accept the recommendation of the superintendent to expel Student C for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year and that Student C must receive anger management counseling

for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year and must provide documentation of such counseling before returning to school for the 2015-16 school year. Motion carried 4-0.

A motion was made by Eddie Harrison and seconded by Tammye Sherrill to adjourn. Motion carried 4-0.
